

Dealing with the death of a baby is clearly an incredibly difficult event for parents. It is internationally encouraged by midwives, bereavement practitioners, still birth/neonatal charities, and academics that bereaved parents should be given the option of spending as much time as possible with their baby. This is usually in the hospital maternity/labour ward but increasingly babies are also being allowed home. The problem is that in a warm room the baby's condition can deteriorate quickly, therefore cooling the baby is absolutely essential. Through use of the CuddleCot families can be given more of that valuable time to form an important bond with their baby; whether changing a nappy, dressing the baby, taking photographs or simply just staying close and this helps families in dealing with their loss.

TeamEvie can offer a CuddleCot for families to use in their own home through their own funeral director. The CuddleCot can be collected from **TeamEvie** by the funeral director who will sign a Loan Agreement giving them full responsibility for the care and safe return of the equipment. Simple operating instructions will also be given. If required, a specially adapted Schnuggle Moses basket can also be provided but parents may prefer to use their own. Please note that **TeamEvie** provide this free of charge and no charge should be made to families.
