All three of our daughters have chronic lung disease, as you can imagine without your monitor we would not be able to have our daughters at home. I was genuinely touched by all the good work you do and I thought you might like to know about the positive impact it is having on families.

We have been to many memorial type events in the last 5 years...Team Evie's was by far the most beautiful and memorable. It was such a moving and heartfelt evening.

I was overwhelmed by your courageous work through the charity. There were times I felt so scared and alone but knowing what you had been through helped me through — the packs that you provide are so lovely.

My grandson has just spent a week on ward 12 PICU and I sat and read him books from this lovely library and I must say these books provide an escape from the treatments that are ongoing and are definitely a massive help for the children and their families while spending time on PICU.

You have made our worst times so much easier to deal with.

What you have done and given our ward is truly incredible and we are so thankful for the amazing work you do!

The impact of the parent bag we got was huge, knowing that someone was thinking of you when you couldn't think clearly yourself.
